Voting opens for Palmerston's first Christmas Lights competition

Palmerston residents have jumped on board Council's new initiative for a Community Christmas Lights Competition.

Residents were asked to put up their best light displays and register in the competition where they could win a massive \$2000! Voting in the competition is open from 8th until the 19th December with the winner's announced on the 21st December. Palmerston is inviting everyone to come and view all of the Christmas Lights around Palmerston, including the ones that have registered in the competition.

There are two randomly drawn prizes worth \$500 each.

Voting closes 19 December 2021.
